# PUBLIC NOTICE

## NOTICE OF REPEAL OF REGULATION

Pursuant to Act No. 138 of June 26, 1968, as amended, known as the Automobile Accident Social Protection Act, and Act No. 38 of June 30, 2017, known as the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act of the Government of Puerto Rico, the public is hereby notified that the Automobile Accident Compensation Administration (ACAA) intends to repeal ACAA's Rules to Establish Area Per Diem, Rule No. 8287 of December 6, 2012 and to repeal Rules of Adjudicative Proceedings of Medical Services and Benefits, Rule No. 8699 of February 10, 2016.

The aforementioned repeal of regulation is recommended because the dispositions of this Regulations are included or can be included in other existing regulation or laws. The elimination of multiple regulations is part of the public policy contained in Administrative Bulletin OE 2018-009 and the Dale Tijera Project of Fortaleza.

The repeal of both regulations were approved by ACAA's Government Board of Directors in the ordinary meeting held on March 21, 2019. The text of the regulations to be repeal will be available for thirty (30) days from the date of this publication at the following address: Legal Affairs Department, ACAA's Main Offices Building, Tenth Floor, 249 Arterial Hostos Avenue, corner of Chardon Street in Hato Rey, from Monday through Friday, from 8:30A.M. to 12:00 P.M. and from 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M., and online at: [www.acaa.pr.gov](http://www.acaa.pr.gov). Comments on both proposed regulations will be accepted for thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this notice. Comments received via e-mail will be acknowledged within two (2) working days of receipt.

If any person is interested in an oral hearing regarding the proposed amendment to ACAA's Regulation No. 8287 and No. 8699, a written request should be made specifying the grounds that according to their own judgment is necessary to grant the oral hearing. The request for an oral hearing shall be filed electronically or personally in the Administration during the dates and hours herein specified.
